- Section 2. Fees not listed in the previous section are still valid and applicable as noted in their documents of origin to include but not limited to equipment rental fees.
 - Section 3. Bond amounts shall be set as per their respective ordinance or resolution.
- Section 4. For fees which are required to be adopted by State Statute, this ordinance serves as an affirmation and shall not override the governing statute.
- Section 5. Any City official is hereby authorized and directed to refuse service to anyone who refuses to pay the fee established for that service.
- Section 6. The City of Chadron shall have the right to charge, in addition to the above fees, any overtime costs incurred in connection with the service.

Section 7. That any other ordinance or section passed and approved prior to the passage, approval, and publication or posting of this ordinance and in conflict with its provisions is hereby repealed.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect October 1, 2023 and be in full force from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
